ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP: The fee for an associate membership is \$20 dollars. Associate membership is offered to crewmembers and FBYC volunteers. Associate members will receive an FBYC bumper sticker.

Responsibility: The undersigned (skipper/parent/guardian) agrees that it is the responsibility of the undersigned to ensure his/her vessel is seaworthy in hull, rig, and gear and that she is properly manned, sailed, and conforms to all its class requirements. The undersigned agrees to accept full, unconditional responsibility for his/her conduct and the conduct of each member of his/her crew and has sole responsibility for his/her crew and vessel at all times. Weather and sea conditions are to be evaluated by each skipper & crew and he/she is responsible for determining whether or not it is safe to participate.

The undersigned (skipper/parent/guardian) furthermore agrees that the officers, governors, committee members and personnel of the Frostbite Yacht Club Connecticut River Squadron and the Essex Yacht Club are not to be held responsible for any accidents, damage or injury to property (personal or otherwise) boats, crew or guests arising from any incidents caused during or related to any race or activity associated with the Frostbite Yacht Club Connecticut River Squadron racing series and further agrees to indemnify and hold harmless each of the officers, committee members, governors, and personnel from any liability, claim or expense (including attorney's fees) against any or all of these persons.

The undersigned (skipper/parent/guardian) furthermore agrees to be bound by the Racing Rules of Sailing, as adopted by the U.S. Sailing Association, including U.S. Sailing prescriptions when they apply, as well as, the rules of each class concerned, and other such rules as are applicable.

COVID-19 Racers Advisory & Protocols (These guidelines are in addition to any issued by state or local authorities.)

If you or a guest feels sick, has experienced COVID-19 symptoms within the past 14 days, or has within the past 14 days come into contact with someone who has COVID-19 (outside the role of medical professional), you or the guest should not come to the Club or race until you have quarantined and had a negative test for COVID-19.

All vessels must be removed from EYC property within 14 days of the last day of racing. Those not removed will be assessed storage fees at the discretion of EYC. Parking on paved surfaces at EYC or any contact with Chandlery property/docks (left of the launch area) is prohibited and may result in DSQ for the day.

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Sanitize your hands (with your own hand sanitizer) upon arrival to the Club, and after going to the restroom.

The Clubhouse is open to Frostbiters, but everyone is strongly encouraged to be vaccinated before entering the club.

Face coverings are mandatory when inside the Club. This includes restrooms.

EYC protocols for social distancing at the bar and with food must be followed.

Ultimately the decisions regarding COVID-19 protocols is up to the Captains and boat owners while on the water.

While this guidance provides a way for racers, race committee and all those affiliated with FBYC to enjoy racing by limiting risk, all risks to participants cannot be eliminated. Captains and boat owners are ultimately responsible for the safety of their crews and must determine if each crew member should be on board.
